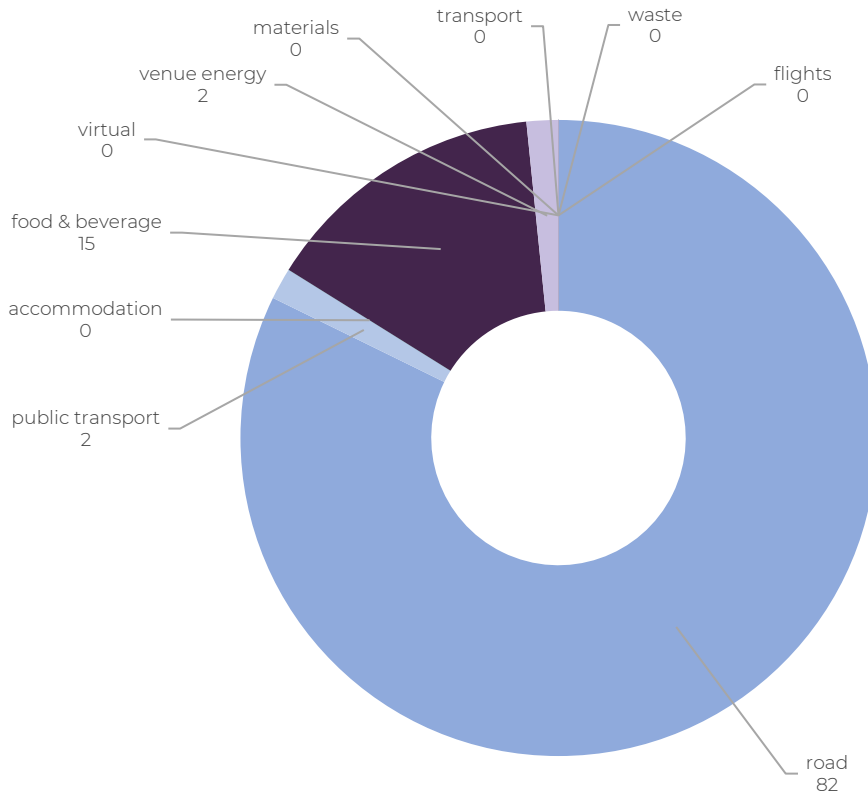
brief

- based at Pennyhill Park, Park View Suite.
- no materials or freight associated with event.
- low-carbon lunch offered within suite.
- visitor travel estimated based on supplier business location. No flights associated and minimal public transport.
- power based on renewable tariff and minimal equipment used during the event.

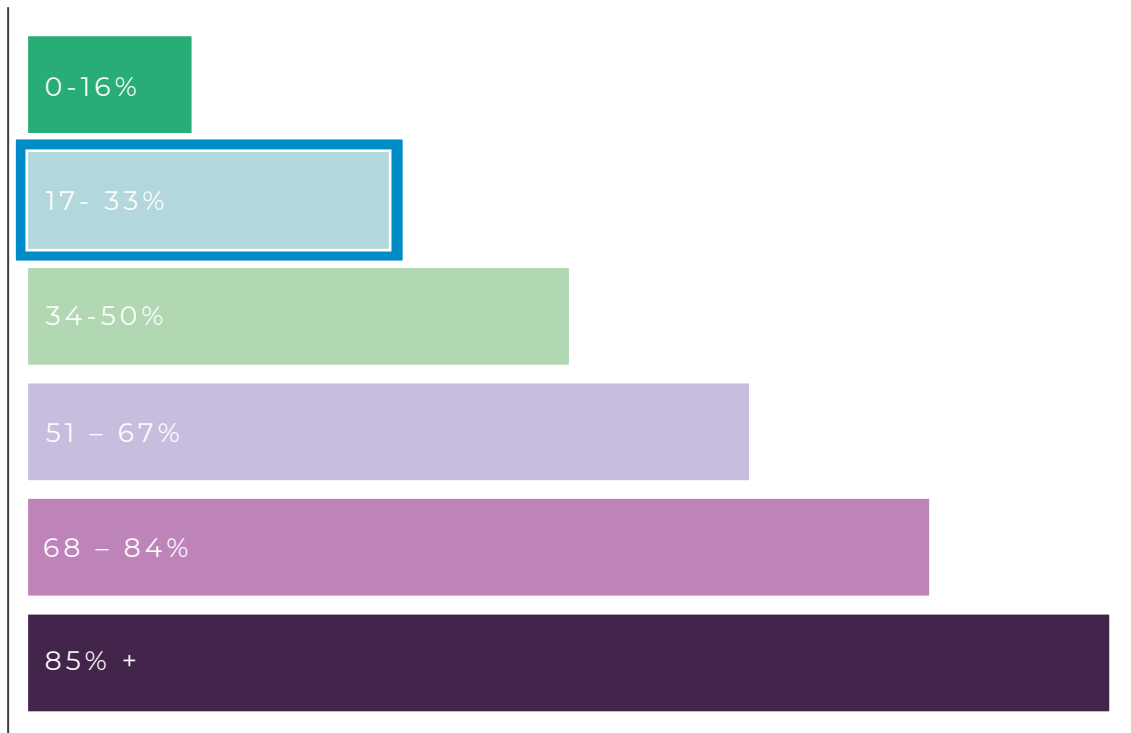

boundaries:

- event** duration (days), guests (where applicable), staff, crew, event area (sqm.)
- travel:** guest, crew and staffing travel by mode (air, private vehicle, public transport) class and distance.
- accommodation:** hotel nights for guests, build crew or stand staffing, by star-rating.
- catering:** includes number of meals (non-vegetarian, vegetarian, vegan) consumed by guests, crew, build staff for duration of event.

in tCO₂e per delegate based on 32 delegates
0.62 tCO₂e = 0.02 tCO₂e per delegate



at this level, **Exclusive Collection Supplier Day 2023** is within the 18th percentile of 'carbon intensity per delegate', benchmarked alongside all **conference** format events measured by event:decision.

based on calculations conducted by event:decision from Mar 2021 –present for comparison purposes.

total data population (conference and exhibition builds) includes events from 50 to 140,000 delegates in virtual, hybrid and in-person event formats at a local, regional and global level, with stand-builds from 3sqm. to 200sqm.



mitigation

Use the data to support mitigating the emissions impact of the next event using a sustainable event planning process.

travel

the majority of delegates attended this event via private vehicle. Although provision is made at Pennyhill Park for EV charging, we note that only two chargers were in use by delegates attending this event. For illustrative purposes, if all delegates had travelled using EV, travel emissions associated with the event would be reduced by c.65%.

food

a low carbon menu was served at lunch at the conclusion of the event, as quantified by your partner Klimato. Whilst in theory a minimal carbon impact can be achieved by provision of a vegetarian menu, you are balancing the demands of the audience with mitigated carbon impact.

materials

paper notepads were consumed during the course of this meeting, produced from recycled sources. No other materials were visible in the delivery of the event, with all tech and furniture used being provided in-house.

offset
